Building Fund for Grades 1 – 12

In addition to tuition, Building Fund must be paid for each student.

The amount of building fund per student is determined by that student's grade level.

Building Fund to be paid:

Students entering 1st grade through 6th grade ... : \$ 500.00

Students entering 7th grade through 12th grade.: \$ 400.00

Maximum of \$1,200 per family/household regardless of the number of children that family enrolls at Calhoun Academy

All new students entering Grades 1 - 12, including those who attended Kindergarten at Calhoun Academy, will pay a \$100 Application Fee. That \$100 is the first payment toward the Building Fund for a student.

In addition, students entering grades 1st – 10th will pay an additional \$25 per quarter or \$100 per year until paid in full.

Students entering 11th grade will pay an additional \$37.50 per quarter or \$150 per school year for the next two years. In total, \$400 will be paid for that student by the end of their senior year at Calhoun Academy.

Students entering 12th grade will pay an additional \$75.00 per quarter or \$300 during their senior year. In total, \$400 will be paid for that student by the end of their senior year.

Payments will be made as follows:

Grades 1 – 10: an additional - \$ 25.00 per quarter until paid in full beginning with the first year of enrollment

Grade 11: an additional - \$ 37.50 per quarter for two years beginning with the first year of enrollment

Grade 12: an additional - \$ 75.00 per quarter for one year beginning with the first year of enrollment

Important Contract and Tuition Reminders

All tuition rates are changing for 2026-2027. Please update your direct pay and 529 Plan payments beginning with your June 2026 payment for the new rate.

Please keep the Tuition Information Sheet where you can refer to it throughout the school year; on your refrigerator is a great spot.

Tuition for the months of June, July and August are due before school starts, so please plan accordingly. Payments can be mailed to Calhoun Academy, PO Box 526, St. Matthews, SC 29135 or dropped in the payment box outside the front office if you are unable to come by during office hours.

We cannot hold spots for students. To enroll, you must submit a completed 2026-2027 contract. A \$100 Application Fee is due if applying for K3, K4, K5, or 1st grade as well as all new students regardless of their grade. Contracts are accepted on a first-come first-served basis until spots are filled.

- March 2 ~ Late Fee of \$50.00 due with contracts for currently enrolled students, including Kindergarten, who did not return contracts before this date
Enrollment opens to new students
- May 10 ~ All 2025-2026 Tuition and Building Fund Fees Must Be Paid in Full—No Exceptions
- June 1 ~ First Quarterly/Monthly/Yearly Payment Due for 2026-2027 School Year
