Dear Guidance Counselor,

One of the most important objectives of the Junior Service League of Orangeburg, Inc. is to support the education of deserving young people in our community. Therefore, we designate a large portion of our annual budget for scholarships for those continuing their education after high school. The number of scholarships awarded varies annually. Only graduating seniors of area high schools are eligible to receive a scholarship from the Junior Service League of Orangeburg, Inc.

The elected Scholarship Committee will rank applicants on a weighted scale in the following categories: (1) service to school and community, (2) need, (3) scholastic achievement and (4) character.

- (1) A student must show service to school and community.
- (2) A student's family must exhibit financial need.
- (3) A student must meet two out of the three following scholastic conditions:
 - o Achieve the South Carolina average on the SAT or ACT
 - o Rank in the top 25% of his or her graduating class
 - o Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. (Please convert scores to this scale.) Official transcripts must accompany all applications.
- (4) A student must illustrate character. To be considered for a scholarship, all applicants must submit three letters of recommendation from two teachers and one community citizen who know the applicant well.

Enclosed you will find a copy of the Junior Service League of Orangeburg, Inc. Scholarship Application. Please make as many copies as needed for students wishing to apply.

Each student is responsible for completing all six pages of the application. However, the guidance counselor/school official must complete page five of the application. Additionally, the principal or headmaster must complete, sign, and date the statement regarding the applicant's character. Stamps will not be accepted as a signature. Completed applications must be postmarked by January 31, 2021. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
